Lion Kimberly was elected Vice President of the International Lions Leadership Alumni Association and assisted in discussion with the International Board of Directors to continue the Leadership Institute, which led to Regional week-long training. Lion Kimberly approached the MD-20 Council of Governors with the idea of sponsoring this type of an institute, and in April, 2001 in Saratoga Springs, the first MD20 Lions Leadership Institute was held. MD-20 has continued its support of our Leadership Institute, and the Leadership Institute is held annually.
