The CAE programs offered do not provide therapy in a Medical treatment context.

- The Motor Skills Program has been carefully designed for Children diagnosed within the spectrum of Autism. To be considered for this program, please fill out and return the enclosed questionnaire TO:CAE Director 64 Fairview Av. Port Washington ,N.Y. 11050. Children will be chosen based on screening process. All eligible participants are required to be cleared by their Doctor prior to enrollment status in CAE. To maximize success, families are expected to follow through with all activities during the course of the program. Our open door policy welcomes existing group professionals to share their methodology and working structure and may assist as necessary to benefit the task completion set forth in his/her activity. Your child's assessment will be generated by his team leader. CAE is designed to provide your child with **Social Interaction** enhancing his/her ongoing therapy. This is not intended to be used as a substitute for existing therapy.
- The Gross- Motor skills program will occur at the Lions Field Location on Sunday mornings from 9:45 to 11:00 a.m. Limited to 18 participants. Staffing will consist of one Certified Master Level Teacher and two aides for three groups of six players .A variety of Brigance Comprehensive Skill Sequences are modified into Sport Activity. Additionally ,there is a gym teacher /Occupational therapist guiding the basics of sports, games and group motor skill activities . Gross-Motor Skills and behaviors will be recorded in participants Inventory and Developmental Record Book. Each session will be recorded –Four sessions are mapped for progress.
- The program will utilize the principals of Applied Behavioral Analysis. CAE Team leaders-(Masters level) will work directly with your child team Aides –using necessary visual aides [ie: flash cards pictures and/ or marker boards ] leaders break down the modified Athletic activity into skill sequences that could be measured and recorded.
- There will be a \$ 60.00 per session charge to families who wish to participate. SIGN UPS ARE FIRST COME FIRST SERVE
